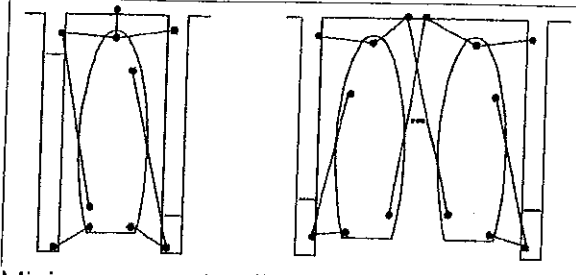


MARINAS

Mooring lines of silver rope shall be permanently attached to the pen cleats of the specific length to keep each vessel secured in its pen. Both ends shall have an eye splice.



Minimum mooring line diameters are:
10-12m berths, 18mm; 13-15m berths, 20mm; 16-20m berths, 22mm; 20-25m berths, 25mm; 25-30m berths, 28mm.

Under no circumstances shall any part of a vessel, including bowsprits, anchors, davits, etc, project over a walkway. Neither shall mooring lines be placed in such a manner as to cause a hazard. Lines shall be laid neatly along fingers when marinas are unoccupied.

Only sausage fenders are to be used in the marina; round or ball fenders are prohibited. Use an appropriate size fender to protect your vessel should it come in contact with the whalers.
